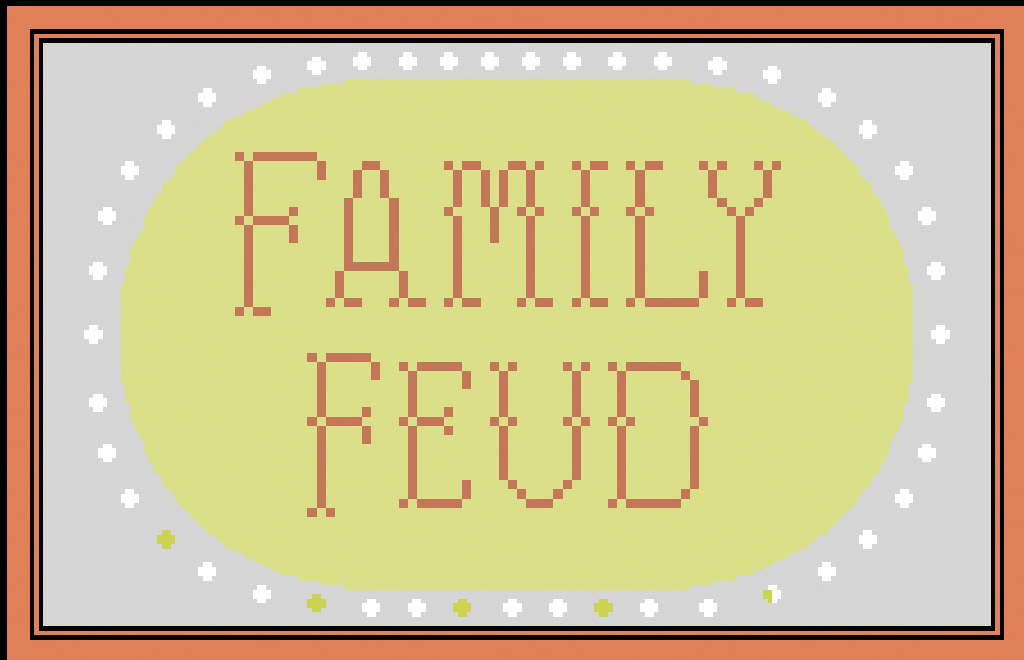

Game Notes

For the edition published December 19, 2008 (check website for updates)

- Use standard 3"-by-3" Post-It Notes to cover up the answers. Double them up, if you need to, to discourage peekers.
- Number the answers 1-2-3 down the left column, and 4-5-6 down the right (don't number any blank squares)
- Encourage the kids (treats often help) and the shy to give it a try. Beware the "answer hogs"
- Read through the answers ahead of time, or else print yourself out a cheat-sheet
- Play any of three "Game Modes":
 - Flex-Mode: Anyone can raise hands with a reply.
 - Traditional Mode: split the table, and select contestants in turn
 - Your Mode: Something different!
- If you want to get fancy, buy a 3-ring binder with a clear overlay on front, print the cover page of this packet out in color, and slip it into the front jacket. And print the "strike" sheets out in color as well.
- Invent your own questions and/or answers to suit your tastes. Post the good ones on the Guestbook at our website
- Don't dwell too long waiting for someone to match the silly answers. If a guest says something funny that's "close enough," then that's a good time to reveal an offbeat answer.
- During the Yom Tov meal, run through as many or as few questions as your guests seem to want.
